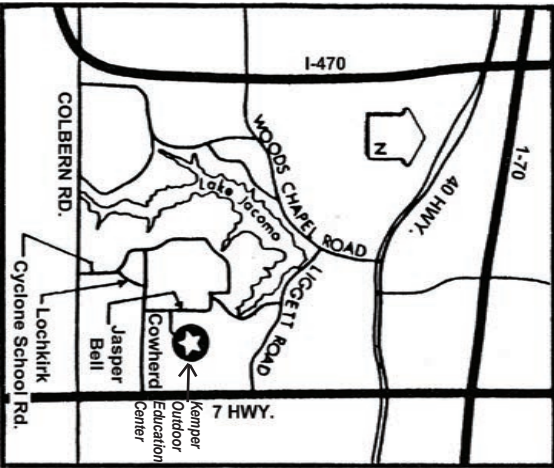

## AGILITY FUN RUNS

Two-minute fun runs are offered in three time slots. Dogs must complete a pre-qualifying run. We reserve the right to refuse dogs not ready for the contact obstacles.

- Agility Fun Run #2 ..... 1:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.
- Agility Fun Run #3 ..... 3:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.

## CANINE ADVENTURE CHALLENGE ...10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

This non-competitive event spells fun and teamwork for you and your dog. Whether you have a puppy to socialize, an energetic dog with trouble listening, a shy dog needing a confidence builder, a senior dog who works at his own pace, a competition dog longing for something new, or a "hotdog" wanting to show off...*this is THE must-do event this year.* The course features 20+ obstacles to intrigue and challenge. It's done on leash, allowing all dogs to join in whether they have advanced training or no training at all. Don't miss out! Ribbons will be awarded to dogs completing the challenge.

## AGILITY CLINIC

Come learn the basic ins and outs of all things agility. In this clinic, you'll learn basic commands used in this sport while introducing your dogs to the awesome world of agility.

## OBEDIENCE SHOW AND GO .....10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Show off what you learned in obedience class (heeling, stand, come and stay in Novice and Pre-Novice). There is no scoring and you may use treats or Gentle Leaders. No harsh corrections or e-collars allowed. Classes offered are:

- Obedience Pre-Novice (on leash)
- Obedience Novice (on and off leash)
- Obedience Open (off leash: jumps & retrieving)
- Obedience Utility (directed retrieves, jumping, scent discrimination)

## RALLY SHOW AND GO .....10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Rally is the hottest new dog sport. Have your dog perform the commands at each sign. You may use hand signals, verbal commands and praise freely. Classes offered are:

- Rally Novice (on leash)
- Rally Advanced (off leash)
- Rally Excellent

## CANINE GOOD CITIZEN TEST .....10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

The American Kennel Club's CGC Program rewards dogs (purebred or mixed) who show good manners at home and in the community. Dogs who pass all 10 exercises receive a certificate from the AKC. Bring your dog's rabies certificate and a dog brush. Details can be found at [akc.org](http://akc.org) (go to Events).

**DOGTOBER FEST 2019  
WAIVER/AGREEMENT/PHOTO RELEASE**

This Waiver and Agreement must be signed by the walker/handler and the owner of the dog for your entry to be accepted. It must also be signed by the parent or guardian of any walker under the age of 18 years.

I give and agree to the following Agreement in one or more of the following capacities and for and on behalf of the following: (1) For myself in all cases, whether or not a participant; (2) for my child or ward if a participant; and (3) for my dog.

I have been advised and understand the following WARNINGS and DISCLOSURES: (i) walking in a park or on a park trail or participating in any dog sport or dog event is potentially a dangerous activity; (ii) no person or dog should enter unless medically able and properly trained; (iii) all participants and dogs should assume any and all risks associated with participating in this event, including, but not limited to falls, contact with other participants, wildlife, motor vehicles, dog bite, tripping, slipping, hazards of natural terrains, alterations to natural terrains, the effects of the weather, the condition of the parks, the condition of event equipment, and the condition of the trails. Having been given these warnings and disclosures, and in consideration of and as a condition to your accepting my entry, I hereby waive, for and on behalf of myself, my dog and my child participant, if under 18 years of age, and release and forever discharge and covenant not to sue, and further agree to hold harmless and indemnify, Jackson County, participating humane societies, all associated dog clubs and organizations and any and all sponsors of the event, their agents, servants, employees, volunteers, assigns, appointed or elected officials, or anyone acting on their behalf from and of any and all claims, demands, causes of action or other relief for damages for personal or bodily injury or property damage of any kind or nature whatsoever arising out of or in the course of participation in this event. This Agreement extends to all claims of any kind or character whatsoever, foreseen or unforeseen, known or unknown.

I further grant permission to any and all of the foregoing to use any photographs, video or any other record for any lawful purpose. If I am participating with a dog I do not own, I will not participate with that dog unless the owner of the dog has read the entry form and this Agreement and executes it, makes all the certifications and warranties contained in it, which I believe to be true.

I affirm that the dog which I own and/or with which I am participating has received all necessary vaccinations, including rabies (if 6 months or older), and is friendly with and not dangerous to other animals or persons. I will keep the dog on a non-retractable leash at all times before, during and after the event. I am able to and will keep the dog under control at all times. I will clean up after the dog.

This Agreement shall be binding upon me, my child or ward, and my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns or anyone else who may claim on my behalf.
